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Middleboro Pediatrics works to improve clinical quality, efficiency for our patients and families. It is MP's policy to continuously measure performance date as a means of identifying opportunities for quality improvement. The continuous measurement allows MP to understand performance strength, weaknesses and improvement opportunities.

MP measures performance in a variety of areas. These areas include immunization rates, preventative care, chronic care, acute care, and vulnerable populations. The monitored areas are determined by the practice's providers and are re-evaluated on a yearly basis. The selected measure may be changed depending on the needs of the practice and its patients.

Generic Medications vs. Brand Name Medications

Middleboro Pediatrics supports the use of generic drugs by making our patients aware of the presence of any generic alternatives to medications they are prescribed. In order to understand the scope of usage of non-generic drugs by our patients, we track the use of non-generic and brand name epinephrine medications.
